The *HSE RIG PASS* program is designed to identify core elements of training programs for new rig employees, and provide effective safety orientation program which is one of the vital element in today's oil and gas industry.

Completion of a *HSE RIG PASS* program confirms that personnel have met basic requirements defined by safety and training professionals in the drilling industry, irrespective of the rigs location. A RIG PASS card will be awarded to each student upon completion which resembles that the bearer has completed RIG PASS instruction as defined by the drilling industry's leading safety and training professionals. Students will complete this program followed by a written and practical test which he or she must pass.
