Overview

This course provides a non-technical overview of the phases, operations, and terminology used in the drilling and completion of an oil or gas well. It is intended for non-drilling personnel who work in the offshore drilling industry. This includes marine and logistics personnel, accounting, administrative and support staff, environmentalists, etc. No prior experience or knowledge of drilling operations is required.
